

## Spring 2010 enrollment

Advisees:

You will need to sign up in the enrollment notebook for one twenty-minute advising session. Please carefully select a time based on the number of credit hours you have completed. You should come in **before your scheduled enrollment date**. Your Enrollment Date can be found in the Student Center on iSIS at <https://isis.k-state.edu>.

You can search for open classes using iSIS or the Course Schedule online at <http://courses.k-state.edu/schedules.html>.

Refer to your Graduation Plan and the College of Education Undergraduate Student Handbook for assistance in completing your schedule and recognizing crucial Teacher Education milestones that you may need to accomplish in the next semester such as:

- Principles of Learning and Teaching or Subject Assessment Test(s)
- Student Teacher Assignment Request Form, CPR/First Aid certification: due by September 1 for spring or February 1 for fall student teaching.
- Professional Development Hours
- University General Education requirements
- Student Teaching Application must be done by December 20 for those who plan to student teach in fall 2010 or spring 2011
- Application for Teacher Education – due for those enrolling in professional classes: October 1 for spring or February 15 for summer or fall.
- Pre-Professional Skills Test

### REMINDER:

**Elementary Education students** must receive permission to enroll in ENGL 355: Lit for Children - go to English/Counseling Services 108 the week before enrollment begins.

**Elementary Education students Enrolling in 'Old Program' Block A** you must have your worksheet signed to obtain permission for classes from the Elementary Education office, BH 261.

**Secondary Education – Art Education students** must receive permission to enroll in studio classes - see Sue Atchison in Willard Hall 206 or email her at [satchiso@ksu.edu](mailto:satchiso@ksu.edu)

**Secondary English students** must receive permission to enroll in ENGL 310 - go to English/Counseling Services Building 108 the week before enrollment begins.

**Secondary Journalism and English/Journalism Education students** you will first need to meet with me to obtain an advisor consent form before you can receive permission from the JMC Department to enroll in MC courses.

Permission for **ESL courses** must be obtained in the CIMA Center, BH 238.
